### Bridge To Transfer/TPP

- Collaboration with TPP staff
- BTP/TPP information session for every senior cohort served by Cal-SOAP
- Collaboration with SJECCD to provide complete CC application, assessment and orientation assistance
- BTP students will attend TMIH collaborative events and complete a TPP application
- Provide school site staff with TPP information and applications

### Career Technical Education Awareness

- Understand all CTE courses offered at school site
- Implement 1-2 school site activities aligned to school career pathways and CTE industry sectors
- Identify CTE school contacts

### College: Making It Happen

- Implement program at each middle school
- Use of CMIH booklets
- Integrate CMIH into existing parent involvement groups when possible
- Target parents of students served by Cal-SOAP

### COSMOS Initiative

- Collaborate with COSMOS staff to develop and implement recruitment strategy
- Identify COSMOS eligible students and provide to COSMOS
- Request student referrals from math and science department faculty
- Implement COSMOS student/parent information session
- Implement COSMOS application workshop

### African American/Native American Outreach

- Identify African American and Native American students at school site
- Implement 1-2 outreach activities designed to increase participation of African American and Native American students in Cal-SOAP cohorts
- Outreach to student ethnic student organizations

### Parent Involvement

- Understand and identify existing parent involvement opportunities at school site
- When possible integrate and collaborate with existing parent groups
- Implement at least two parent involvement activities with intensively served cohort
- Conduct at least two follow-up phone calls with intensively served cohort

### Test Prep Services

- Identify school site contact responsible for test administration
- Ensure all 10th graders served by Cal-SOAP complete the PSAT
- Implement Kaplan free workshops for 10th - 12th at school site
- Implement Kaplan ACT/SAT combo test and score report workshop for 11th
- Ensure all 11th graders register for and take the SAT and ACT exams in Spring

### The Role Model Program

- Identify RM students at your school site
- Provide RM students with two advising sessions
- Include RM students in your Cal-SOAP cohort
- Collect Cal-SOAP applications from RM students
